



- The edible parts of the asparagus plant are the young stems or shoots that emerge in spring. The shoots are often called spears.
- Asparagus shoots can grow up to 12" in 24 hours under ideal conditions like 90 degree temperatures!
- White asparagus is produced by burying the growing shoots under mounds of soil to block the sunlight. This prevents the plant from making green chlorophyll.
- After harvest, asparagus will spoil quickly if not kept cold. Refrigerate with a damp paper towel or with stalks in a few inches of water.
