Farm Facts:

Torre and Leslie grow seaweed in Fairhaven at one of the only seaweed farms in California! Each year they produce 20,000 pounds of edible seaweeds in tanks on the shore of the Humboldt Bay using a method called tumble culture. They also grow kelp in the open water of the bay to help with the restoration of native kelp forests along the north coast.
