## Don't leave financial aid money on the table!

### Top 5 things YOU MUST DO to maximize your financial aid:

1. Submit Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov) between Oct. 1 - March 2.
2. AB 540 students complete the free, secure online CA Dream Act Application at [www.caldreamact.org](http://www.caldreamact.org) between Oct. 1- March 2.
3. Confirm that your high school submits your verified GPA for the Cal Grant program by March 2.
4. Apply for national & local scholarships. Check out free searches online and see your school counselor for help.
5. Talk to your family about paying for college. Tell them they can assist you just by helping you complete the FAFSA or CA Dream Act application.

# APPLY EARLY!

The earlier you submit the FAFSA or Dream Act application, on or after Oct. 1, the faster it will be processed, and the greater likelihood you will receive the MAXIMUM amount of financial aid you are entitled to.
