Cal Poly Humboldt's Admissions Process

Apply through CSU Application

All students are initially admitted based on self-reported information through their CSU Application.

It is very important that students take their time entering their information in correctly.



Confirmation Emails

Students will typically receive a confirmation email from us **two to five** business days after submitting their application.

The confirmation email is basically telling them that we have received their application.



Applicant Status Page

About **two weeks** after the application submissions, student will get an email from our office explaining how to log in to myHumboldt/Applicant Status Page.

We recommend they check their Applicant Status Page at least once a week for important updates, especially regarding their admissions decision.



Admissions Decision

Most, if not all, students will go through an auto-evaluation process for their admission decisions.

Went through the auto-eval process?

For Fall 2025, Admissions decisions will be released in mid-November.

After that, Admission decision are given within 2-3 business weeks of receiving their confirmation email.

For those who need to go through a **manual evaluation**, their admissions decision email will depend.



Final Evaluation

Students must submit their official final transcripts (high school and/or college) in **July** to be evaluated.

This is when we will officially see if a student truly meets our admissions requirements.



Submitting Transcripts

We accept both **electronic** and **mailed** transcripts.

We also can accept them in-person at the Admissions Front Desk. However, they need to be **sealed**.

For official electronic transcripts, we currently accepts them via Parchment, National Student Clearinghouse, Scriborder, and SCOIR.
