- □ A G coursework (15 units)Grades in A G courses
- ☐ GPA: Grades in A-G courses
- ☐ High School Graduation
- □ 2.5 GPA (different in local context)
- Impacted majors may exist on some campuses
- ACT/SAT test to determine placement (no longer used for admissions)





 - O Bachelor's of Arts & Science
 - O Master's Degrees
 - O Doctorate Degrees
- Requirements
 - O A-G Subject Requirements
 - O GPA
 - O Graduation



Eligibility Criteria for UC's



- Eligibility
 - A G coursework (15 units total)
 11 of them complete before the
 12th grade.
 - High School Graduation
 - 3.0 minimum weighted GPA (no grade lower than C)
 - Impacted campuses/majors may require SAT Subject tests
- Top 9% in your class = guaranteed admission (UC's overall if min. req. met)
- Holistic Review
- SAT/ACT may be used as alt. method of fulfilling min. requirements or course placement

Personal Insight Questions (PIQ's)

- O You will have 8 questions to choose from. You must respond to only 4 of the 8 question
- O Each response is limited to a maximum of 350 words.
- O Which questions you choose to answer is entirely up to you:
 - But you should select questions that are most relevant to your experience and that best reflect your individual circumstances

3 examples (out of 8)

- Describe an example of your leadership experience in which you have positively influenced others, helped resolve disputes or contributed to group efforts over time.
- O Describe how you have taken advantage of a significant educational opportunity or worked to overcome an educational barrier you have faced.
- O What have you done to make your school or your community a better place?

Holistic Review: 13 Factors Beyond grades and test scores

- O Academic GPA
- O Courses beyond A G
- O Honors/AP/IBO
- O Top 9% of HS class, end of junior year
- Senior Year Classes
- Doing all you can with what is offered

- O Outstanding in a subject
- O Outstanding projects
- Marked academic improvement
- O Special talents/achievements
- Special Projects tied w/curriculum
- Accomplishments in light of tougher circumstances
- Location of your school/home

Average Cost of Attendance

- On Campus:
 - \$45,300 (ish)
- O Off Campus:
 - \$43,600 (ish)
- O TUITION & Fees: \$20,134

Estimated average costs for California residents, 2025–26

This chart estimates the cost of attending UC for one year as a new California resident undergraduate. For a significant proportion of our students, these expenses are offset by grants and scholarships.

Keep in mind that your total cost will vary depending on your personal expenses and the campus you attend.

Impaction (both CSU's and UC's)

- O Impaction means that a campus receives more eligible applicants then they can accommodate and therefore must restrict enrollment to that campus (often requiring higher eligibility standards)
- Impacted Campuses
- Impacted Majors and Programs
- Impacted Groups: (Freshman, Transfers)

Similarities





- Public Institutions
- A G Rigorous Curriculum
 - GPA after 9th Grade
- ACT or SAT exams for placement
- Offers Bachelors, Masters, and Professional Degrees
- Have impacted/closed majors at some campuses
- Only have to fill out one application for all 23 CSU's or 10 UC's. (Fee's apply to each)
