Foster Youth Services

Created by the California Department of Education, Foster Youth Services assist foster youth to meet their educational needs through a collaborative effort.

Foster Youth often experience numerous changes in placement and interruptions in school. The emotional adjustments of these changes combined with the sense of falling behind in school can be overwhelming. Studies place the high school graduation rate of foster youth between 38 and 46 percent. In order to support foster children academically and emotionally, the FYS program was established to meet these needs.

FYS Education Liaisons

Education Liaisons assist with:

- ◆ Immediate enrollment in school
- ◆ Timely transfer of educational records
- ◆ Improving youth academic achievement
- ◆ Improving attendance and reducing truancy and dropout rates
- ◆ Reducing incidence of pupil discipline problems and juvenile delinquency
- ◆ Linkage to community college/vocational programs

Homeless Youth Education Services

State education agencies and local education agencies must ensure that each homeless child and youth has equal access to the same free, appropriate public education, including public preschool programs, as other children and youth.

Supportive services to homeless youth are as follows:

- ◆ The right to immediate enrollment in school regardless of living situation.
- ◆ Assistance with school services to maintain educational stability
- ◆ Opportunities for academic success
- ◆ Assistance obtaining immunizations and medical records
- ◆ Continued attendance in the school in which last enrolled
- ◆ Receive transportation from your current residence to school of origin
- ◆ District trainings
- ◆ Linkage to community college/vocational programs
