

LOITERING OR CAUSING DISTURBANCE

The Board of Education and Superintendent recognize that students have the right to a safe environment in which to learn. Therefore, any person who is not a member of the school staff or student body and who loiters on or about any school building or grounds without permission or who causes disturbances may be guilty of disorderly conduct and may be prosecuted according to law. It is, therefore, required that all visitors register in the office of the principal and receive approval to be present on any campus.
