FACILITIES: SECURITY

The Superintendent or designee shall establish such procedures and systems as may be needed to provide for the security of property, buildings and grounds owned and/or operated by the Office of Education. These procedures and systems shall reflect the following considerations:

- 1. Minimizing fire hazards
- 2. Reducing the probability of accidents from faulty equipment or facilities
- 3. Guarding against the chance of electrical shock or exposure to other hazards
- 4. Keeping records and funds in a safe place
- 5. Protecting against criminal activity, including vandalism and burglary
