

FACILITIES: SECURITY

The Superintendent or designee shall establish such procedures and systems as may be needed to provide for the security of property, buildings and grounds owned and/or operated by the Office of Education. These procedures and systems shall reflect the following considerations:

1. Minimizing fire hazards
2. Reducing the probability of accidents from faulty equipment or facilities
3. Guarding against the chance of electrical shock or exposure to other hazards
4. Keeping records and funds in a safe place
5. Protecting against criminal activity, including vandalism and burglary
