Staff Development

The Superintendent recognizes that professional development enhances employee effectiveness and contributes to personal growth.

The Superintendent or designee shall develop a plan for professional development based on a systematic assessment of the needs of Office of Education staff and students participating in our educational programs. Development activities are intended to meet the changing conditions in education while enhancing personal growth and shall be aligned to the Office of Education's vision, goals, local control accountability plan, and other comprehensive plans.

Professional development services shall be provided to Office of Education employees and local school district personnel by the Office of Education.

Such services shall be comprehensive and needs-based in nature. The basic functions of the Office of Education shall include coordination, communication and direct delivery of services.

The Superintendent shall authorize Office of Education employees to attend conferences, workshops and meetings at Office of Education expense when deemed necessary to improve the performance of the individual employee and/or enhance programs and services offered by the Office.
