## **CLASSIFIED PERSONNEL**

## Leaves

Personnel may wish or be required to be absent from work for several reasons:

- 1. Those caused by personal sickness or injury, pregnancy, court duty, military service or emergencies beyond their control.
- 2. Those governed by compassion or conviction, such as family illness or childrearing, bereavement, and other reasons of compelling personal importance.
- 3. Those stemming from occupational status such as attendance at work-related meetings, conventions, inservice courses and seminars, and other patterns of additional study.
- 4. Those provided by scheduled recesses or vacations.

The Superintendent recognizes that absences for such reasons are justifiable and will provide for employee absences as authorized by law, as permitted in the following policies and regulations, or as negotiated between the Superintendent and authorized employee organizations.

The following policies and regulations regarding leaves apply to those employees not otherwise covered by a negotiated agreement between the Superintendent and an exclusive representative.

## Continuity of Service

No absence under any paid leave provision of the following policies and regulations shall be considered as a break in service for any employee who is in paid status, and all benefits accruing under the provisions of these paid leave policies shall continue to accrue during such absence.

Employees who are on an approved leave of absence shall notify the employer by March 1 whether or not they intend to return from leave for the following school year.

Employees on unpaid leaves may continue to participate in the health and welfare benefits program(s) if the premium(s) are paid by the employee.
