

**Admission**

No child shall be unconditionally admitted to any school without presentation of a fully documented immunization record as required by law, unless otherwise exempted.

The Superintendent of Schools or designee shall maintain procedures which provide for the verification of all entrance requirements governing student health examinations, oral health assessments, immunizations and infectious diseases.

In addition to evidence of immunization, proof of age shall be required of all enrolling students. The legal evidences of age, in order of desirability, are as follows:

1. Certificate of birth
2. Baptismal certificate
3. Passport
4. Immigration certificate
5. Religious record

If the above documentation is unobtainable, the principal or designee shall accept a sworn statement from the parent/guardian which provides the name, age, birth date and birthplace of the student, the name(s) of his/her parents and the basis of such knowledge.

**Admission of Students with Disabilities into Court and Community Schools**

The Superintendent shall develop admission procedures for students with disabilities into Court and Community School programs that achieve the following standards:

- 1) The educational rights of students with disabilities is protected; and
- 2) Services to be provided, if any, are to comply with federal and state requirements; and
- 3) Should a service required by a student with an IEP not be available due to the unique structure of Court/Community Schools, that all appropriate steps be taken to recommend a more suitable educational environment; and
- 4) That all parties, including the student and his/her parent or guardian, the Humboldt County Probation Department, the referring school district, Court/Community Schools staff, and any support providers related to special education services, be involved in the educational placement decision in accordance with all applicable laws.
