## Graduation - High School

Pupils who complete one or more of the courses of study offered by the Humboldt County Office of Education, satisfy Office of Education standards, and pass any required assessments shall receive a high school diploma signed by the Superintendent of Schools, the President of the Board of Education, and the school's principal.

Completion of a course of study shall require the passing with a mark of D or higher.

Nothing in this policy shall be construed as prohibiting courses of study from imposing additional graduation prerequisites. (See Board Policy 6146.1, Secondary Program Completion and High School Graduation Requirements).

High school graduation ceremonies shall be held to recognize those students who have earned a diploma
