## **Workforce Related Student Services**

The Board of Education recognizes the importance of providing quality, responsive and coordinated student services including those provided by the Humboldt County Office of Education and local public and private non-profit agencies. The Board believes that services for students should be comprehensive, avoid unnecessary duplication and be coordinated at the local level to serve students. Services for students should reflect youth development principles and include options for improving academic and occupational skill competencies. Services should address the abilities and interests of each individual through mentoring, community service and leadership opportunities. To that end, the Board of Education adopts the following framework for student services.

The office supports comprehensive workforce related student service programs which include:

- Career and academic assessment services,
- Information to school and community resources,
- Tutoring, study skills training and instruction,
- Alternative secondary school options, as appropriate,
- Summer employment opportunities,
- Paid and unpaid work experience,
- Occupational skills training,
- Leadership development opportunities,
- Community support services,
- Adult mentoring,
- Follow-up services, and
- Comprehensive guidance and counseling.
