

Student Production of Services and Materials

Students may use school materials, supplies, equipment, and facilities only for the educational purposes of the instructional program in which they are enrolled.

Costs of services and products produced in school laboratories that are intended for non-school use or consumption shall be borne by the user or consumer when such costs are over and beyond normal instructional and materials costs.

First priority for availability of services and products offered for non-school use (such as the servicing of automobiles in career technical education shops) shall be reserved for students of the school.
