## **Special Instructional Programs**

In order to provide for children whose present and future educational needs are not being satisfactorily met in a regular classroom, special classes will be organized as these services are needed and to the extent it seems feasible to do so.

## Policies Applying to All Special Classes

- 1. Age at entrance will determine services offered. Preadolescent children should be given preference for enrollment in community schools.
- 2. Since these programs are a part of the total school program, all school policies apply to personnel and students, except where physical conditions of the child make it impossible to carry out such policies.
- 3. Close cooperation of parents is desirable and necessary. To this end, a plan for parent education shall be developed.
