ATTORNEY

The Board of Education recognizes the complex legal environment in which schools and county offices of education operate and desires reliable, dependable legal advice. The Board also supports collaborative legal efforts with other agencies, school districts and offices of education in order to promote the Office of Education's interests.

In contracting for legal services, the Board of Education and the County Superintendent shall appoint the same legal counsel.

The legal counsel may:

- 1. Render legal advice to the Board and the County Superintendent or designee.
- 2. Serve the Board and the County Superintendent or designee in the preparation and conduct of Office of Education litigation and administrative proceedings.
- 3. Perform other administrative duties as assigned by the Board and County Superintendent or designee.

The Board may authorize a specific member to confer with legal counsel on behalf of the Board.
