ORIENTATION

New Board Member Orientation

The Board and the County Superintendent or designee shall help each new member-elect or appointee to understand Office of Education operations and the Board's functions, policies and procedures as soon after election or appointment as possible. Incoming members shall be given copes and informed that they must conform to the requirements of the Brown Act as if they had already assumed office. Incoming members shall be referred to the Office of Education's online policy manual and given the County Election Official's contact information and other materials related to the Office of Education and Board member responsibilities.

Incoming members are encouraged to attend Board meetings and meet with the County Superintendent or designee and Board president regarding their roles and responsibilities. They also may, at Office of Education expense, attend workshops for new Board members.
