## **MEETINGS AND NOTICES**

## Circumstances under which the Humboldt County Board of Education may hold meetings outside county boundaries (Government Code 54954)

Board meetings may be held outside county boundaries only under one or more of the following circumstances:

- 1. When necessary to comply with state or federal law or court order, or to attend a judicial or administrative proceeding to which the Board of Education is a party.
- 2. To inspect real or personal property which cannot conveniently be brought into Humboldt County, provided that the topic of the meeting is limited to items directly related to the property.
- 3. To participate in meetings or discussions of multiagency significance, provided these meetings are held within one of the other agencies' boundaries, with all participating agencies giving the notice required by law.
- 4. To meet in the closest meeting facility if the Office of Education has no meeting facility within its boundaries.
- 5. To meet with state or federal officials when a local meeting would be impractical, solely to discuss legislative or regulatory issues affecting the Office of Education over which the state or federal officials have jurisdiction.
- 6. To meet in or near a facility owned by the Office of Education but located outside the county, provided the meeting is limited to items directly related to that facility.
- 7. To visit the office of the Board of Education's attorney for a closed session on pending litigation, when doing so would reduce legal fees or costs.
