EVALUATION OF COUNTY OFFICE OF EDUCATION AND COUNTY BOARD OPERATIONS

The Board of Education believes that in order for it to know how well the County Office is progressing toward its several goals and objectives it needs regular and comprehensive information. The County Superintendent will develop procedures for gathering and presenting data needed to the Board.

The Board may review policies and administrative regulations annually to ensure that they reflect the needs and interests of the community with respect to the Office of Education programs and to assure conformance with law.

The Board may develop and implement a self-evaluation.
