As a result of a thoughtful and thorough review by staff at the Humboldt County Office of Education, you will find attached findings that lead to a recommendation for denial of the charter petition for the Samoa Beach Academy (SBA).

I would like to acknowledge the manner in which SBA representatives interacted with the HCOE staff during the review process. Petitioners were responsive in their communications, courteous and respectful in all their interactions with staff, and displayed a positive and consistent commitment to their cause. Moreover, it is my belief that this petition, though flawed, highlights and elevates the importance of CTE in Humboldt County.
