College Persistence Program for Incoming College Freshman

Summer Link Program: This program is designed to keep our local collegebound students on-track by offering information and support during the transitional summer season before college to prevent "summer melt", a surprisingly common scenario in which high school graduates apply, are accepted, and plan to enroll in college but don't follow-through.
