- 8. Code of Conduct for Employee-Pupil Interactions (if applicable)
- 9. Information on immigrant pupils' rights to free public education

- 11. Information about availability of the the School Accountability Report Card
- 12. Title I/Every Student Succeeds Act required notifications (as applicable)
