Driving from San Francisco Bay Area:

Head north on U.S. 101. Eureka is about 250 miles north of San Francisco.

Driving from Sacramento Area:

Head north on I-5, then west on CA-299 from Redding to the coast, then south about 10 miles.

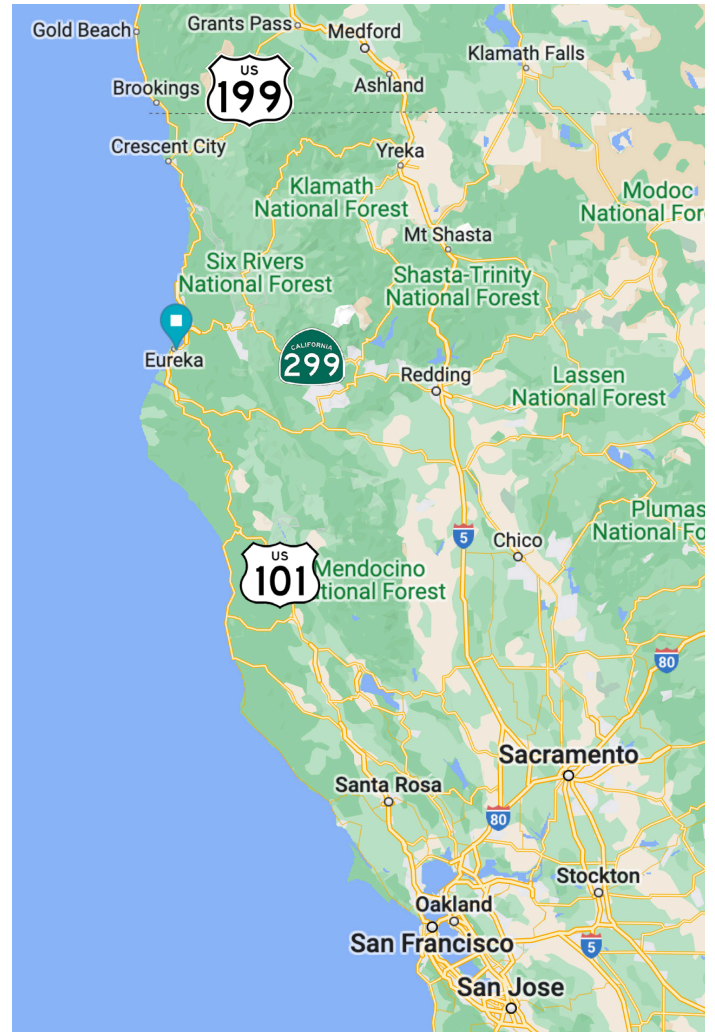
Driving from Oregon:

If you're on the coast, take U.S. 101 South. If you're in the middle, take I-5 to Highway U.S./CA-199, until you reach U.S. 101. Continue south.
