# Talking With Parents When You Have a Concern About a Child in Your Care Tuesday, May 26 & Tuesday, June 16 | 3 Hours PD Credit

- Provide a framework for caregivers when they have concerns that a child in their care might have a
  developmental delay, disability, or significant behavior problem.
- Discuss how to share concerns with a child's parents or family members (anyone raising the child) and understand different ways family members will receive and act on the expressed concern.

- Define inclusive practice, describe collaboration, and share practical strategies.
- Discuss the intended use in child care settings for children birth through age 12 years.
