## School Exclusion for **Unvaccinated** Students During <u>a Measles Outbreak</u>



Tyler is diagnosed with measles. This starts the 21-day exclusion period for <u>unvaccinated</u> and **exposed** students.



Fern is diagnosed with measles 10 days after Tyler. Because she is now the most recent case, the 21 day exclusion period for <u>unvaccinated</u> and **exposed** students restarts.



Carter is diagnosed with measles 12 days after student 2. Because he is now the most recent case, the 21 day exclusion period for unvaccinated students restarts

Start exclusion period

lf no other cases are diagnosed, unvaccinated students may return to school (21 days later) exclusion period extended an additional (21 days after the most recent case) If no other cases are diagnosed unvaccinated students may return to school (21 days later)

exclusion period extended an additional (21 days after the most recent case)

21 Day exclusion starts for **everyone** below 21 Day exclusion starts/ restarts for **everyone** below (because this indicates an ongoing outbreak at the school)







Every time a new student is diagnosed with measles, unvaccinated students will start their 21 day exclusion period over. An outbreak at school can cause unvaccinated students to be excluded for weeks or even months.
