Dear Humboldt County Office of Education,

Thank you for partnering with us over the past few weeks to plan and prepare for the vaccination of our educators and support staff of the school districts and charter schools in Humboldt County. With your help and the help of district superintendents, we have defined two groups of educators and support staff to be vaccinated:

GROUP 1: In person educators and support staff providing services to students on site (1000) GROUP 2: Distance learning educators and support staff (2100)

Beginning today, the first group of educators and support staff, those that are doing either full time or partial in person instruction will be extended invitations through their district superintendents or designees. The first rounds of vaccination clinics will be available January 27th through January 31st. Additional clinics are being planned for the following weeks as new vaccine supply becomes available. New invitations will come as new clinics are created. If staff are not available for one of the currently scheduled clinics, need to reschedule, or if no appointments are available when you open your link, there is an appointment request/ reschedule function that is at the bottom of the invitation email. Please note that this is only for Group 1 staff at this time. Distance learning and those who work in an office without students will be invited as Group 2 as more vaccine supplies become available.

We expect that all educators and support staff in both group 1 and 2 will be invited for appointments by February 12th.

Please remember that anyone on quarantine or isolation should wait until after the quarantine or isolation period ends to get vaccinated. To encourage an orderly and efficient distribution of vaccines these invitations should not be forwarded to others.
