
These are JUUL pods.

These e-liquids come in a variety of flavors like cool cucumber, mango, fruit medley, and more.

What is concerning about JUULs?

- Nicotine is addictive and harms the developing brain.
- The JUUL has one of the highest nicotine strengths on the market at 59mg/ml.

The maximum strength of nicotine in an e-liquid sold in the European Union (and U.K.) is limited to 20mg/ml due to a Tobacco Products Directive that came into effect on May 20, 2017.



What should you do?

Know what to look and smell for.

- JUULs look like a USB drive and might blend in with school supplies.
- JUULs come in fruity and sweet smelling flavors and do not leave a long lasting odor, like cigarettes.
