NATIONAL:

- **Total cases: 981,246 (+23,371)**
- **Total deaths: 55,258 (+1,336)**

**Total jurisdictions includes 50 states, District of Columbia, Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, Puerto Rico, and the U.S Virgin Islands.

STATE:

As of April 27:

- **45,031 positive cases (+1,567)**
- **1,809 deaths (+54)**

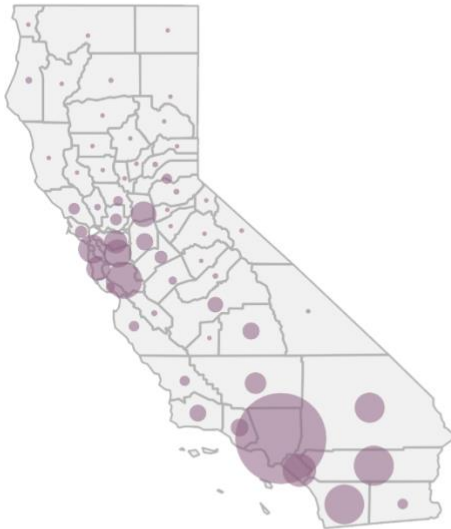

Daily COVID-19 case report for April 28

- Total number of positive cases: 53
- Total number of hospitalizations: 4
- Total number of recovered cases: 52

- Total number of people tested by Public Health Laboratory: 1,378
- Total number of people tested by all other sources: 708
(Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, California Department of Public Health and commercial labs)

The Public Health Laboratory currently has a capacity of approximately 1,200 tests and can process about 60 samples a day with an approximate turnaround time of 48 to 72 hours.
