- **Total cases 1,193,813 (+22,303)**
- **Total deaths: 70,802 (+2,523)**

\*\*Total jurisdictions includes 50 states, District of Columbia, Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, Puerto Rico, and the U.S Virgin Islands.

### STATE:

- **58,815 positive cases (+2,603)**
- **2,412 deaths (+95)**

- Total number of positive cases: 55
- Total number of hospitalizations: 5
- Total number of recovered cases: 52
  
- Total number of people tested by Public Health Laboratory: 1,848
- Total number of people tested by all other sources: 859

The Public Health Laboratory currently has a capacity of approximately 1,100 tests and can process about 65 samples a day with an approximate turnaround time of 48 to 72 hours.
