

NEWS ALERTS AND UPDATES – May 11, 2020

NATIONAL:

- **Total cases 1,324,488 (+23,792)**
- **Total deaths: 79,756 (+985)**

**Total jurisdictions includes 50 states, District of Columbia, Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, Puerto Rico, and the U.S Virgin Islands.

STATE:

- **67,939 positive cases (+5,427)**
- **2,770 deaths (+185)**

Approximately 991,897 tests have been conducted.

CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION:

Today, State Superintendent Tony Thurmond, administrators and educators from districts across the state met digitally with Congressman Ted Lieu (California's 33rd Congressional District, United States House of Representatives) to speak about how California is serving students during this time, and how Congress may be helpful in providing aid to schools and districts to benefit families, educators, administrators and school staff.

Two Cases Involve Assisted Living Facility
+2 were also confirmed over the weekend bringing total to 61

The following information is based on the most recent data available for all confirmed cases:

- Contact to a Known Case: 28
- Travel-Acquired: 20
- Community Transmission: 11
- Under Investigation: 2

Daily COVID-19 case report for May 11

- Total number of positive cases: 61
- Total number of hospitalizations: 6
- Total number of recovered cases: 57

- Total number of people tested by Public Health Laboratory: 2,046
- Total number of people tested by all other sources: 1,177
(Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, California Department of Public Health and commercial labs)

The Public Health Laboratory currently has a capacity of approximately 1,500 tests and can process about 65 samples a day with an approximate turnaround time of 48 to 72 hours.
