NATIONAL:

- **Total cases 1,384,930 (+20,869)**
- **Total deaths: 83,947 (+1,701)**

STATE:

- **73,164 positive cases (+2,023)**
- **3,032 deaths (+98)**

LOCAL:

Total new positive cases confirmed on May 14: 1

Humboldt County's total number of confirmed COVID-19 cases is now 68 as one additional positive was confirmed today.

Testing conducted by the Public Health Branch at Alder Bay Assisted Living found one person who provided care at the facility has become positive for the virus. Ongoing testing of staff and residents will continue.

Contact investigations determined one previous case was acquired through travel outside of the area, and another was acquired through community transmission. Humboldt County Health Officer Dr. Teresa Frankovich said, "Travel will be an ongoing concern, but the virus is here in Humboldt County and circulating in our community. We should all continue to practice social distancing and other measures that can decrease transmission risk as businesses start to reopen." Two cases remain under investigation.

The following information is based on the most recent data available for all confirmed cases:

- Contact to a Known Case: 32 (+1)
- Travel-Acquired: 21 (+1)
- Community Transmission: 13 (+1)
- Under Investigation: 2

Daily COVID-19 case report for May 14

- Total number of positive cases: 68 (+1)
- Total number of hospitalizations: 9 (+1)
- Total number of recovered cases: 53

- Total number of people tested by Public Health Laboratory: 2,261
- Total number of people tested by all other sources: 1,502
(Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, California Department of Public Health and commercial labs)

The Public Health Laboratory currently has a capacity of approximately 1,500 tests and can process about 65 samples a day with an approximate turnaround time of 48 to 72 hours.
