NATIONAL:

- Total cases 1,571,617 (+90,797)
- Total deaths: 98,261 (+4,111)

STATE:

- 96,733 positive cases (+8,289)
- 3,814 deaths (+184)

Approximately 1,696,396 tests have been conducted.

- Total number of people tested by Public Health Laboratory: 2,806
- Total number of people tested by all other sources: 2,917 (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, California Department of Public Health and commercial labs)

The Public Health Laboratory currently has a capacity of approximately 1,925 tests and can process about 65 samples a day with an approximate turnaround time of 48 to 72 hours.
