- **Total cases 1,678,843 (+107,226)**
- **Total deaths: 99,031 (+770)**

Total jurisdictions includes 50 states, District of Columbia, Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, Puerto Rico, and the U.S Virgin Islands.

### STATE:

- **98,980 positive cases (+2,247)**
- **3,884 deaths (+70)**

All four of the new cases were acquired through contact with another known case.

The following information is based on the most recent data available for all confirmed cases:

- Contact to a Known Case: 57 (+4)
- Travel-Acquired: 24 (no chg)
- Community Transmission: 17 (no chg)
- Under Investigation: 0 (no chg)

### Daily COVID-19 case report for May 27

- Total number of positive cases: 98 (+4)
- Total number of recovered cases: 72 (+6)
- Total number of hospitalizations: 13 (+1)
- Total number of deaths: 2 (no chg)
  
- Total number of people tested by Public Health Laboratory: 2,866
- Total number of people tested by all other sources: 3,004  
(Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, California Department of Public Health and commercial labs)

The Public Health Laboratory currently has a capacity of approximately 1,900 tests and can process about 65 samples a day with an approximate turnaround time of 48 to 72 hours.
