May 29, 2020 - One New Case Confirmed Today

One new case of COVID-19 was confirmed today, bringing to 99 the total number of Humboldt County residents who have tested positive for the virus.

OptumServe Test Site Data Now Reported Six Days a Week, Commercial Lab Data Available Each Friday. The Humboldt County Emergency Operations Center will begin reporting the number of COVID-19 tests conducted at the OptumServe test site in Eureka six days a week. Commercial laboratory testing data, which is irregularly received, will be reported each Friday.

- Contact to a Known Case: 58 (+1)
- Travel-Acquired: 24 (no chg)
- Community Transmission: 17 (no chg)
- Under Investigation: 0 (no chg)
