- **Total deaths: 104,396 (+2,685)**

31 jurisdictions report more than 10,000 cases of COVID-19

### STATE:

- **113,006 positive cases (+9,120)**
- **4,251 deaths (+183)**

#### **Governor Newsom Signs Executive Order on Actions in Response to COVID-19**

The order allows individuals enrolled in teacher preparation programs during the 2019-20 school year to obtain their preliminary credential without a teaching performance assessment, if the individual was unable to complete that requirement due to a COVID-19 school closure. Under the order, individuals otherwise eligible to obtain certain teaching or education specialist credentials or enroll in teacher preparation programs are permitted to do so without passing

certain assessments, for which testing was suspended due to the statewide stay-at-home order.
