### NATIONAL:

- **Total cases 1,827,425 (+24,955)**
- **Total deaths: 106,202 (+1,045)**

\*34 jurisdictions report more than 10,000 cases of COVID-19

### STATE:

- **117,687 positive cases (+2,377 +2.1%)**
- **4,361 deaths (+75 +1.7%)**
