CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

State Superintendent Tony Thurmond to Release Guidance for Safe Reopening of Schools on Monday, June 8. [Watch on FB Live 11:15 a.m.](#)

State Superintendent Tony Thurmond will release the CDE guidance document, “Stronger Together: A Guidebook for the Safe Reopening of California’s Public Schools,” on Monday, June 8. During a news conference Monday at 11:15 a.m. on Facebook Live, Thurmond and CDE leaders will walk through the document’s key tools and recommendations.

This guidance will serve as a road map of recommendations for schools as they work with their local public health officials and school communities to navigate next steps. Educational leaders will find recommendations for face coverings, physical distancing, and symptom screening should schools plan to provide some form of in-person instruction and distance learning. The document will also provide in-depth considerations for designing high-quality and equitable instructional practices for all students.

On Monday, June 8 at 1 p.m., State Superintendent Tony Thurmond will join the webinar, "Preparing Students For The Future: Addressing Covid-19, Distance Learning & Racial Justice," hosted by the California Association of African American Superintendents and Administrators (CAAASA), in partnership with UCLA's Center for the Transformation of Schools and California Collaborative for Educational Excellence.

This one-hour webinar will address the impact of the pandemic on instructional scheduling, households with multiple students, opportunities for academic support, parental support, caregiver considerations, and access to technology devices and reliable wi-fi.
