*3,694,345 tests have been conducted.

LOCAL:**June 25, 2020 – Five New Cases Confirmed Today**

Five additional cases of COVID-19 were reported today. Humboldt County's total case count now stands at 127.

Of the five new cases, four were acquired through contact with a known case, and the means of transmission for the remaining case is under investigation.

The following information is based on the most recent data available for all confirmed cases:

- Contact to a Known Case: 73 (+4)
- Travel-Acquired: 26 (no chg)
- Community Transmission: 23 (no chg)
- Under Investigation: 5 (+1)

- Total number of positive cases: 127 (+5)
- Total number of recovered cases: 105 (+2)
- Total number of hospitalizations: 14 (no chg)
- Total number of deaths: 4 (no chg)

Number of tests run since last report

- Public Health Laboratory: 49
- OptumServe public testing site: 126

Total tests run to date

- Public Health Laboratory: 4,154
- OptumServe public testing site: 4,304
- Willow Creek public testing site: 42
