LOCAL:**June 29, 2020 - Four New Cases Reported Today**

Humboldt County's total COVID-19 case count now stands at 133, after four additional cases were reported today.

Beginning today, the Humboldt County Joint Information Center will replace the text-only testing results with graphics from the COVID-19 data dashboard. The dashboard provides more comprehensive data than was previously available in a format that is easier to access and understand.

Daily COVID-19 case report for June 29

- Total number of positive cases: 133 (+4)
- Total number of recovered cases: 115 (+10)
- Total number of hospitalizations: 15 (no chg)
- Total number of deaths: 4 (no chg)

Public Health Laboratory testing Information

- Supply capacity: Approximately 2,200 tests
- Testing capacity: 70 samples per day
- Turnaround time: 48 to 72 hours
