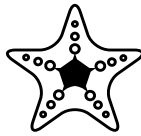
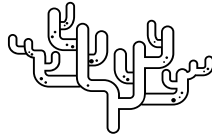
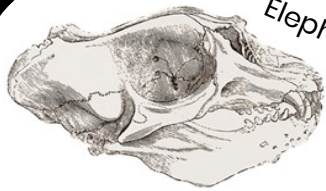


Seabirds and Seals: Skulls and Awesome Adaptations

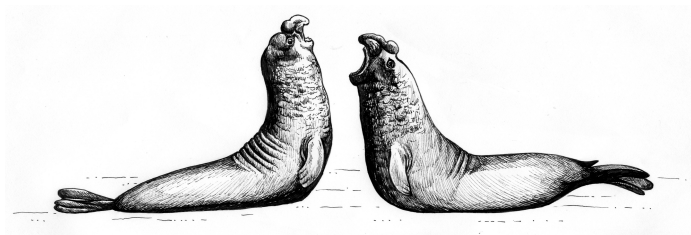
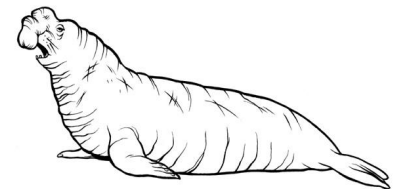
Find the Northern Elephant Seal Skull!

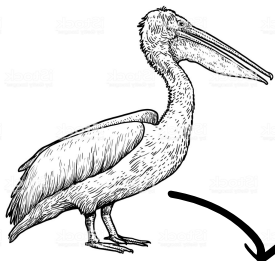
